Established in 1983 at the Georgia Institute of Technology in Atlanta, the regional organization continues to grow and now encompasses eleven southern states. **SESAH** is the Southeast Chapter of the national Society of Architectural Historians (SAH) and a nonprofit 501 (c) (3) organization.

As a member of **SESAH** you will receive:

■ Subscription to the **SESAH NEWSLETTER** published three times annually, which keeps members informed of upcoming events, conferences, grant and career opportunities, awards, publications, and exhibitions.

■ Subscription to **ARRIS**, an annual scholarly journal, first published in 1989. Article topics have varied from Thomas Jefferson's classicism to TVA's modernism and from rural plantations to urban theaters. Southern scholars have also contributed articles ranging from the German Bauhaus to the Los Angeles roadside.

■ Invitation to attend and participate in the **ANNUAL MEETING**, held each fall at a southern city, town, or university. Scholars present professional papers on diverse topics of architectural history. Experts lead special tours of local architectural landmarks. In the past, keynote speeches have been given by such luminaries as James Ackerman, Stanford Anderson, P. Reyner Banham, Andreas Duany, Michael Graves, William Jordy, Dell Upton, and John Michael Vlach.

■ **BIBLIOGRAPHIES** on southern architecture, compiling recently published articles, theses, dissertations, and books by southern scholars and/or on southern architecture.
